<p><u>Ordinary Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	3.30	.83	.55
<p><u>Expedited Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.</p>	4.40	.83	.55
<p><u>Daily Transcript</u> A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day.</p>	5.50	1.10	.83
<p><u>Hourly Transcript</u> A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.</p>	6.60	1.10	.83
<p><u>Realtime Transcript</u> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.</p>	2.75	1.10
