Administrative Order

As the United States District Court is required to implement procedures for essential functions during Phase 2 of the Government Shutdown, the Court also recognizes the mandates of Speedy Trial Act for time limits during various stages of a criminal case.

In criminal cases, the Court finds that the time of any continuance entered during Phase 2 of the Government Shutdown shall be excluded under the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), as the Court finds that the ends of justice served by taking that action outweigh the interests of the parties and the public in a speedy trial.
